Our Superstars are busy preparing for their upcoming state STAAR tests. The first tests will be the 4th grade writing and the 5th grade math and reading tests. These tests will be on Tuesday, April 9th and Wednesday, April 10th. 4th and 5th grade students are asked to leave their cell phones at home on STAAR days. Students taking STAAR will be served a free breakfast the morning of the test. Sheridan will be closed to all visitors on STAAR testing days. It is very important that students arrive on time and are here for the full day. As you can imagine, many doctors have openings on these days since students state wide are testing. We ask that you please not make appointments for your testing students on STAAR days. STAAR is timed and students must complete the test during that specific time.

Please continue to have all students read at home to improve their skills in all areas.
