You must have the required documents to register:

- Birth certificate
- Social Security Card
- Shot Records
- Parent Photo I.D.
- Proof of Residency: At the time of registration, parents will be asked to provide proof of residency dated within the last 30 days. Documents that are provided should reflect the parent/legal guardian's name and street address. Please be prepared to submit one item from Line A and one item from Line B.
 - Line A: (Lessee) Verification in the form of your current lease/(Homeowner) Verification in the form of HCAD records, a mortgage statement, or closing documents
 - Line B: Verification in the form of your current gas, water, or light bill

*** We will not be registering students under NSR {None Secure Residence} or VOA {Verification of Address Affidavit} for PRE-REGISTRATION.

Medication Pickup: It's that time of year again...Please make arrangements for yourself or another responsible adult to pick up your child's medication before the end of the school year. Cypress Fairbanks ISD policy does not allow students to transport medicine to and from school. All medicine not picked up by **May 30, 2019 at 3:00 pm** will be **discarded**.

Make sure that your child receives any required vaccines prior to the first day of school. You will also need to send the updated shot record to school. Updated shot records can be mailed or faxed to the school. If you are not sure that your child needs an immunization, you can call the clinic and I will review their current shot record and inform you if shots are needed.

Summer is a great time to start fresh with healthy activities, healthy food choices, and safety practices. If there are wheels under their feet, put a helmet on their head! Limit snacks and drinks high in sugar or salt. Try limiting sodas and fruit drinks-research shows it makes a big difference in kids' health. Spend time as a family doing indoor and outdoor activities even chores around the house can be a source of exercise and "together" time. A good night's sleep is important every night - even when school is out. Healthy children need to grow in height and weight every year, but excess weight, lack of sleep and high blood pressure can lead to a lifetime of health problems. The choices and practices you teach them now can make a world of difference to their future.

Library Books Due


All student library books are due by Thursday, May 16.
